Preamble

In view of the exigencies of scientific and technological development resulting in socio-economic changes, unpleasant events at political level and at other matters have been occurring indomitably throughout the globe. Courses of Study

- The syllabus has been designed for the students of Master of Social Science (MSS) Program in Political Science which is divided into two groups **Group A** and **Group B**.
- **Group A** is designed for the students with a Bachelor Degree (Pass) or Honors in any other discipline and **Group B** is designed for the students who have a Bachelor Degree (Honors) in Political Science.
- The Duration of MSS Degree Program of **Group A** is 2-Years divided into 6 (six) Semesters, and **Group B** is 1-Year divided into 3 (three) Semesters.
- Students of **Group A** is required to complete 20 Courses including Viva-voce and Comprehensive for a total of 60 credits; while **Group B** is required to complete 11 Courses including Viva-voce and Comprehensive for a total of 33 credits.
- Each course contains 100 marks and 3 credits. Marks for Viva-voce and Comprehensive written test are 50 each.
